TO: WEIGHTS AND MEASURES OFFICIALS

SUBJECT: Web Accessibility Standards for Official State of California Websites

Assembly Bill 434 (Baker, Chapter 780, Statutes of 2017) requires all state agencies, including the California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA), to make web content more accessible to people with disabilities and users with limited devices, such as mobile phones. The deadline to comply with Web Content Accessibility Guidelines 2.0 was July 1, 2019.

To meet this requirement, CDFA is undergoing a redesign of both format and content for all division websites to meet the *Americans with Disabilities Act* (ADA) accessibility requirements. As part of this redesign, DMS has relocated many documents intended for county officials to the "CDFA DMS Portal for County Weights and Measures Officials" at the following link: <u>www.cdfa.ca.gov/dms/countyreports/countyreports.html</u>.
