TO WEIGHTS AND MEASURES OFFICIALS

SUBJECT: E-Waste Recyclers

The Electronic Waste Recycling Act of 2003 established a funding system for the collection and recycling of certain electronic wastes. The California Integrated Waste Management Board further adopted regulations that establish a Covered Electronic Waste (CEW) Recovery and Recycling Payment System to pay licensed entities for these activities.

To participate in the CEW Recovery and Recycling Payment System as a recycler, an individual or firm must be a licensed weighmaster as defined in Section 12700 of the Business and Professions Code (B&P Code). An approved, sealed device must be used to determine the amount of e-waste and a weighmaster certificate must be issued for all transactions. (Note: The exemption in B&P Code Section 12733, when both buyer and seller are present, does not apply to e-waste payments.)

If a person wishes to participate as a collector only in CEW programs, and they are not submitting recycling activities for payment, a weighmaster license is not an eligibility requirement for the CEW Recovery and Recycling Payment System.
