## **Bio-security/Grounds**

Procedure designed to limit pest (birds, rodents, insects, etc) infestation of feed and or feed ingredients.\*

# **Pest Control**

## Objective:

To maintain a proactive approach to pest control that will minimize the exposure of ingredients or formula feeds to pests.

### Person Responsible:

Plant Manager or Designated Employee

#### Procedure:

Facility should consider contracting with a local pest control company to design a program that is tailored to the individual plant.

All pesticides of any kind will be labeled and stored in a designated location where they cannot come into contact with any animal food or contact surfaces.

Employees must follow the designated pest control program and check the traps accordingly.

#### Frequency:

Pest control program must be followed on every production day.

#### Verification:

Maintenance check form must be completed that shows who and when the traps were checked.
