

Wetting Agents and Surfactants Labeling Aid

Use the following labeling formats if your fertilizing material includes a wetting agent, such as a surfactant or soil penetrant:

- If the wetting agent or surfactant is an ingredient of an **Auxiliary Soil and Plant Substance**, the labeling should have the following format:

NONPLANT FOOD INGREDIENT(S):

% Polymers (state names of the specific polymers)

% Wetting Agent (state name of the specific wetting agent)

Submit a Materials Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) or Safety Data Sheet (SDS)

- If the wetting agent or surfactant is an ingredient of a **Commercial Fertilizer**, **Specialty Fertilizer**, or **Agricultural Mineral**, the labeling should have the following format:

ALSO CONTAINS NONPLANT FOOD INGREDIENT(S):

% Polymers (disclose specific name of polymers to CDFA – not required on the label)

% Wetting Agent (disclose specific name of wetting agent to CDFA – not required on the label)

- If the wetting agent is an ingredient of a Packaged Soil Amendment, include the **Wetting Agent** in the ingredient list. Disclose the specific name of the wetting agent for CDFA records only.
