The following risk mitigation strategies are suggestions to assist the grower/shipper in preventing glassy-winged sharpshooter from infesting loads of bulk citrus:

- 1) Under the monitoring of the origin County Agricultural Commissioner (CAC), citrus is treated in a manner approved to eliminate adult/nymph GWSS.
- 2) Mechanically brush and protect citrus from infestation by vectors; or
- 3) Post harvest treatment of citrus; or
- 4) Use of other means to eliminate GWSS adults/nymphs from bins of fruit approved by the CAC.
- 5) Distribute industry produced pamphlets or educational cards to field personnel, regarding the artificial spread of GWSS.
- 6) Ensure all management practices and mitigation measures are consistent with the California Department of Food and Agriculture’s (CDFA) Statewide Pest Prevention Program Final Programmatic Environmental Impact Report.
